### 2. Publications:

Multi-RCM (driven by ERA-interim) comparison of South Asia climate variability

*(Try to collect subset of v required data (only) from groups early 2013. Insist on CORDEX format 1-2 papers on this will encourage other groups to get involved).*

Multi-RCM (driven by historical CMIP5 GCMs) : *Try to collect relevant data ~March/April 2013*

*Some coordination is needed to get a good sampling of driving GCMs.*

*Criteria: Global Climate Sensitivity, present climate (global) performance, large-scale circulation quality for South Asia*

*Aim to sample GCMs by the 3 criteria above + have 1 or more GCM sampled by >1 RCM.*

Multi-RCM (driven by projection part of CMIP5 GCMs): *~May/June 2013??*

*\*\*Use suitable resolution observations (esp. precipitation) consider observation uncertainty*

*\*\* Apply some suitable monsoon metrics-of-performance for evaluation papers.*

*\*\* Consider impact-indices for evaluation and climate change papers.*

### **3. Outreach**

Bias-correction of precip/temp from the multi-RCM matrix for use by impacts models.

Development of a set of regionally-interesting impact indices to be calculated based on the multi-model S.Asia matrix.

Impact/sector oriented article(s) from S-Asia runs as soon as possible in suitable journals

South Asia CORDEX sessions at suitable regional conferences, both in India and neighbouring countries?

South Asia CORDEX session in pan-CORDEX conference (or part of a wider Asia session)
